Minutes for PSG Monthly Meeting - October 2, 2019 Regency Hotel, Chisinau

Welcome and Update from PSG Committee

Daniel Lee opened the meeting, welcoming parents and introducing new committee members, Ecaterina Papanaga, Leanne Field and Varvara Leventopoulou-Berdy.

Treasurer Report:

John Sax reviewed the **PSG budget**: PSG spent 4,500 lei for wine and cheese night. The balance is currently 20,000 lei (\$1100, €1030).

PSG Structure

John Sax reviewed the PSG committee structure and outlined a new election process to ensure continuity of the PSG. The structure and process will be published and disseminated once it is finalized.

- There are three elected committee officers: Chair, Vice Chair and Treasurer
- The committee is recommended to include up to 10 members
- PSG recommends that each calendar year, elected committee officers will step down and the committee will hold elections to instate new officers
- The committee meets regularly. However, weekly committee meetings can be adjusted based on membership
- PSG encourages parent involvement and will request additional parents offer support for larger efforts or projects (e.g., Fall Festival, International Fair)

Director Jon Routh supported formalizing a succession plan and process to ensure continuity of the PSG.

PSG Event Discussions

Trunk or Treat Fall Festival planning

The annual event is scheduled for November 8 from 6-8 pm at QSI. George Khevsuriani and Ellen Depies led a discussion to prepare for the event.

The group brainstormed some ideas for this year (pizza, games and activities for kids, using the leftover wine from Wine and Cheese night for parents, etc.). Ellen is leading a parent planning committee for the event, and will coordinate with the teacher committee.

The planning committee will put out call for parent help for the event and for clean up after the event. We will also need at least 10-11 parents to decorate their cars and bring candy for the trunk or treat portion of the event, and may request families to bring snacks. Upperclassmen are also encouraged to help out with activities during the event.

PSG Hike

Daniel encouraged parents to attend the next hikes, scheduled for October 19 and November 16. There are no hikes scheduled for the winter months; hiking will begin again in the spring, probably by March or April.

Update from Director Jon Routh

School Calendar Changes

QSI HQ is hosting a professional development event for regional teachers in Minsk. The school calendar was updated to change November 20 from a half day to no school to allow teachers to travel to Minks.

March 6 is now a full day of school.

No further calendar changes are anticipated.

Advisory Board Meeting Update

The Advisory Board, appointed by QSI Headquarters, advises Jon on topics relevant to school functioning. Jon reported the board has not done fundraising in Chisinau, traditionally. Forfeited discounts (tuition discounts offered but not taken) are not significant in Chisinau. However, the board has not decided how to use them yet this year. Historically they have used this to pay for travel for coach or advisor when QSI students take a school-related trip (e.g., Week without Walls)

Building Project

The outside work – to include the parking lot, walkway and landscaping – and the inside – to include the library, cafeteria and lobby – are on pace to be completed by the end of October, on time, within budget.

MAP Testing

Jon reminded parents that MAP testing is not high-stakes placement testing. The purpose is to see students' performance levels and what their growth has been to support classroom work with their teachers. The results have been given to teachers who are reviewing and making plans for instruction.

Results will be given to parents during parent teacher conferences; returning parents should note the format has changed, but the information is the same as last year.

MSA Committees

MSA evaluated QSI Chisinau on 12 standards – accounting, curriculum, etc. – and we are waiting on them to give final approvals.

Three goals came out of the review and created the school's seven-year plan:

- o Mathematics
- o Service learning
- Technology (use in the building)

MSA Committees, comprised of parents and school staff, will begin moving forward on implementation of the plan and goals.
